



Important Information for 2017 Season of Hope Toy Shop REGISTERED SHOPPERS!

****ATTENTION****

Please help us make this the best possible experience for you and your fellow shoppers by following these guidelines:

Due to requests from the Town of Newton, the Newton Police, and local business owners, as well as in an attempt to relieve traffic congestion and ensure the safety of all of our shoppers, there is a **NEW PARKING PROCEDURE** for the Season of Hope Toy Shop this year. Please follow this procedure carefully!

STEP ONE – All Shoppers must go first to the Sussex County Community College Upper Lot on Plotts Road. Once there, you will be directed to a line and given a numbered parking tag.

STEP TWO – NO CARS MAY ENTER THE PSS PARKING LOT DIRECTLY. Only cars that have lined up at SCCC Upper Lot on Plotts Road & have received your numbered parking tag will be allowed entry to the PSS lot. Newton Police will direct you to drive to the PSS Campus when space becomes available. **Make sure your parking tag is clearly displayed; only those with parking tags will be allowed entry to PSS.**

STEP THREE – As you enter the campus, you will be directed by police and volunteers to the nearest available parking space. Park your car and go to Building #4 (Little Sprouts) to enter the Toy Shop.

STEP FOUR – Once you are finished shopping, please **immediately** exit the Toy Shop, load your car and drive to the exit. At the exit, a volunteer will take your parking tag.

The **only** parking for the Toy Shop is at the Project Self-Sufficiency's campus. **Only those who have first gone to the SCCC lot and received a parking tag will be admitted. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD YOU PARK ON THE ROAD OR IN ANY LOT OTHER THAN PROJECT SELF-SUFFICIENCY'S.** Do **NOT** park in any other lots, such as local businesses – both the Newton police and store security will be patrolling for violators. We have been advised by the Town of Newton and the police that **anyone who does so will be ticketed and have their car towed at their own expense.** No drop-off's will be allowed; please be prepared to experience some wait times and delays. Shopping later on Friday or on Saturday should lessen the wait times and crowds, providing for a more enjoyable shopping trip.

We ask you to be patient with the new procedures, bearing in mind that they have been put into place for your own safety as well as the safety of the community.

The Season of Hope Toy Shop can be crowded and hectic. The new parking procedure will be a challenge, and you may experience some long waits. Please remember that hundreds of PSS staff, volunteers, and generous community donors have been working hard for months to bring the Toy Shop together.
